An autonomous and project-based curriculum encourages independent learning while opening doors for collaboration between students of each grade level. There are no “typical” classrooms, as many of the learning labs host operable walls and glass entries for learning on display while several are not enclosed by walls at all. The concept of “learning happens everywhere” guided design through the incorporation of flexible learning spaces and technology into every corner and utilizing the building itself as a tool to complement instructional methods. Students are visually connected to nature throughout, leading to a professional setting for independent learning to flourish.
