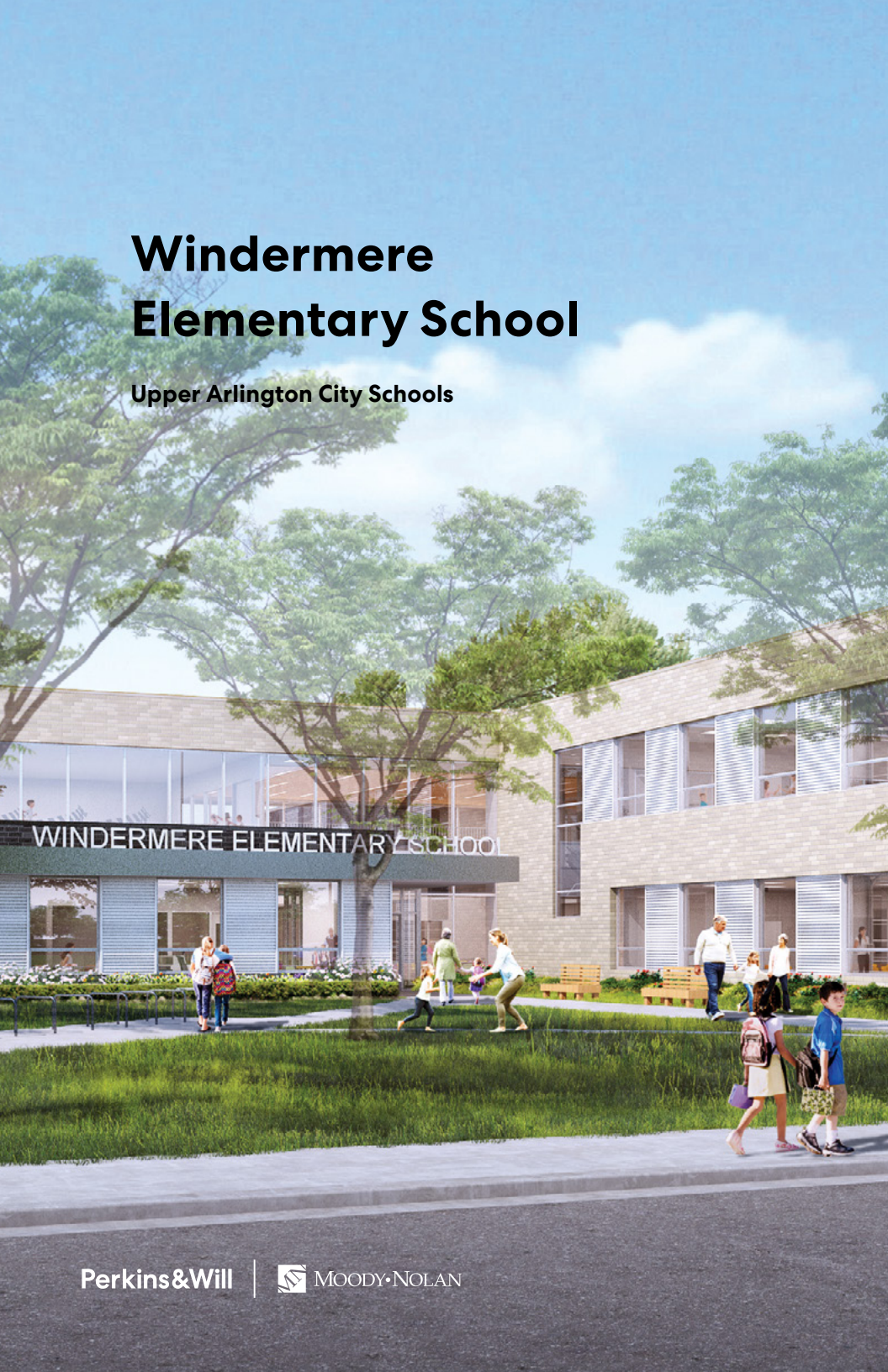

New replacement school functionally organized around adjacent centrally located two-story dining commons and media center

Secure entry vestibule works in concert with other security features

Art, music, and other special classrooms easily accessible from central spaces

Gymnasium sized for community use with music/stage function at end

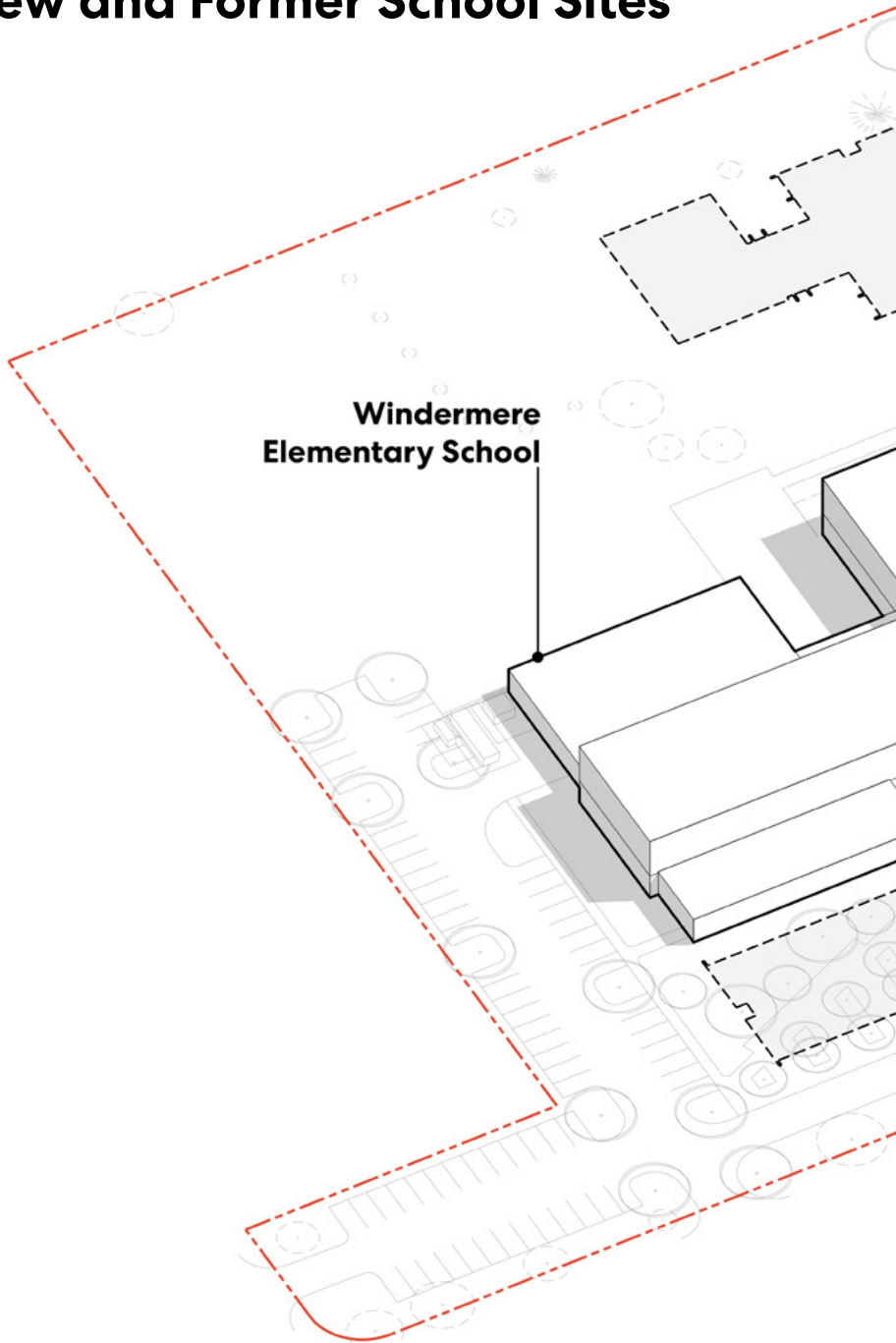
Ample outdoor learning, play, and open areas integrated into overall site plan



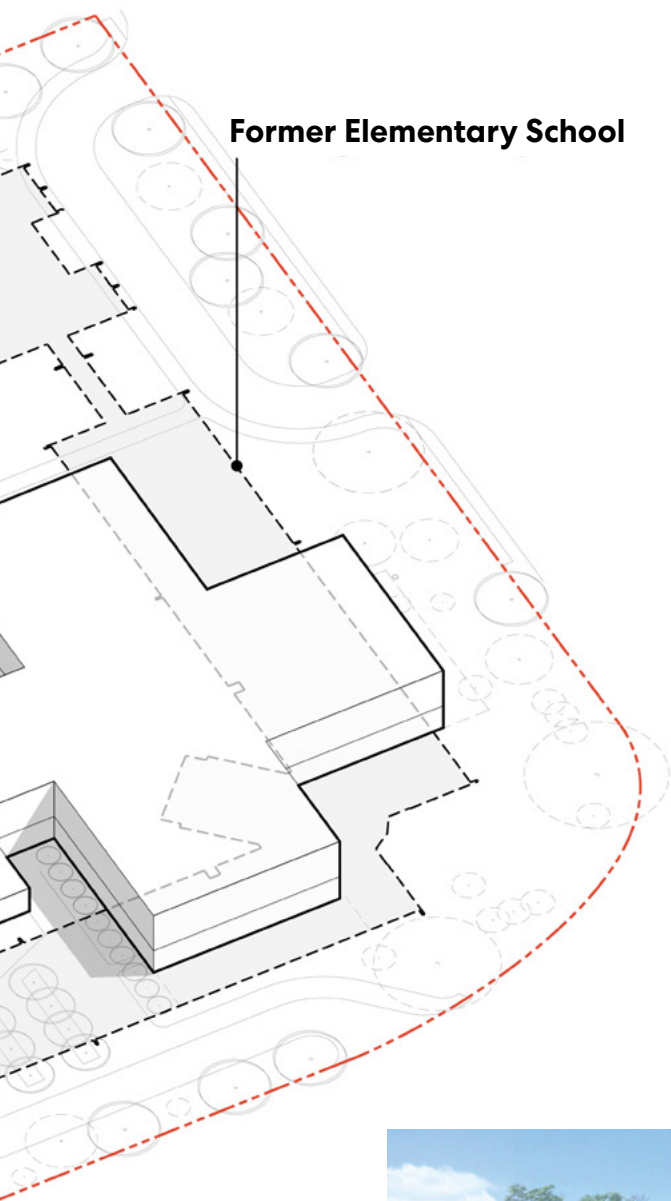
The new elementary school will give students future-ready, agile learning environments.

The school was built on the same site as the existing building. Efficient planning led to highly creative use of space, and in keeping with current needs for flexibility and collaboration, academic neighborhoods are wrapped around the 2-story open media center. This increases accessibility for students and encourages inquiry and exploration.

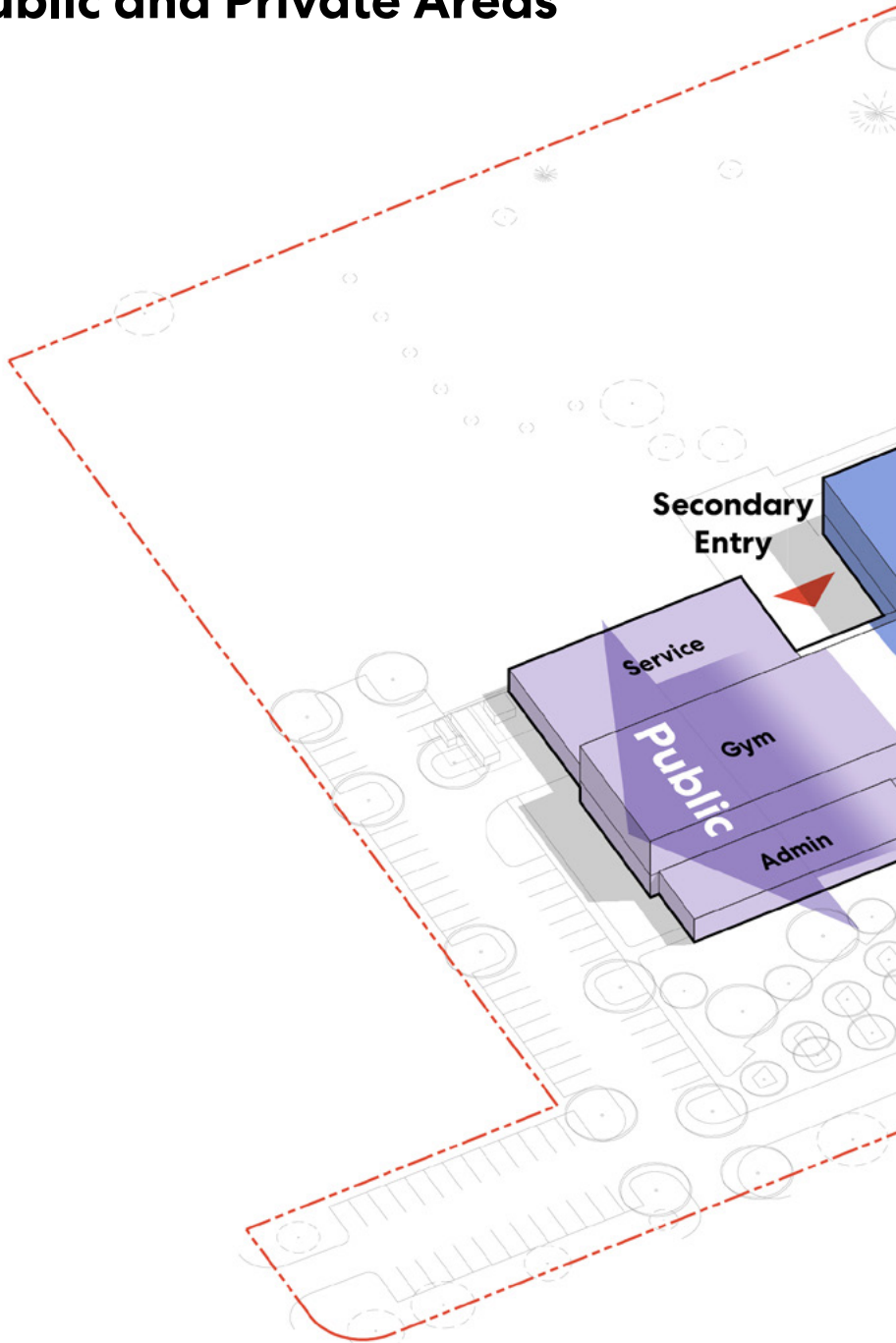
New and Former School Sites

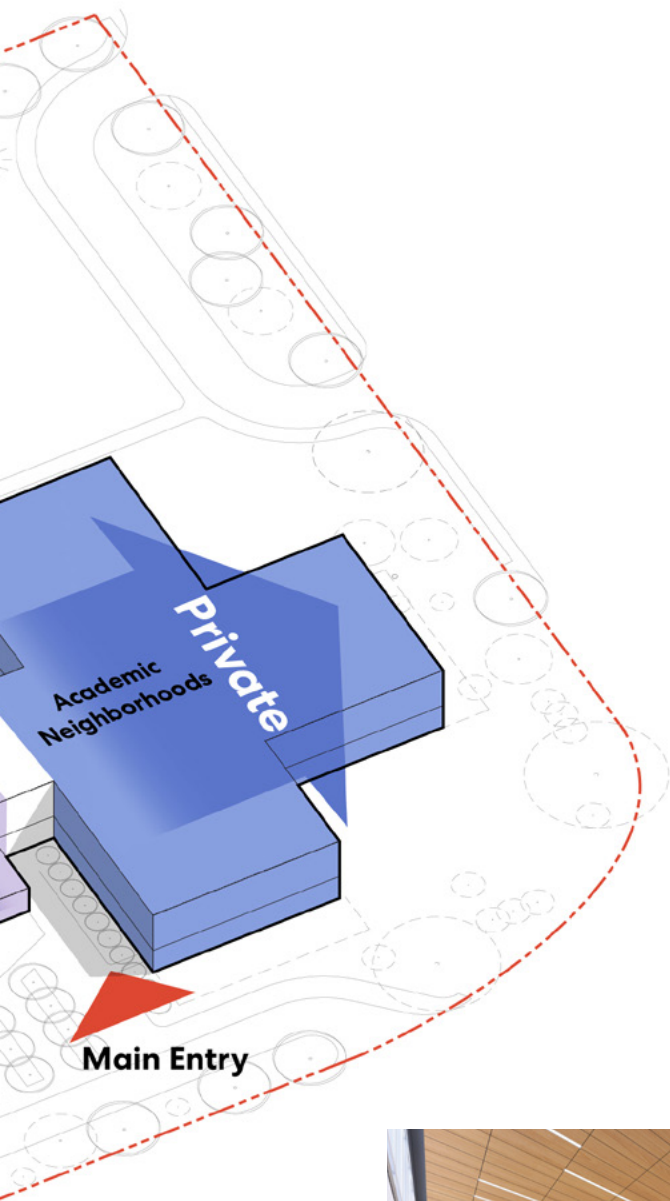


Former Elementary School

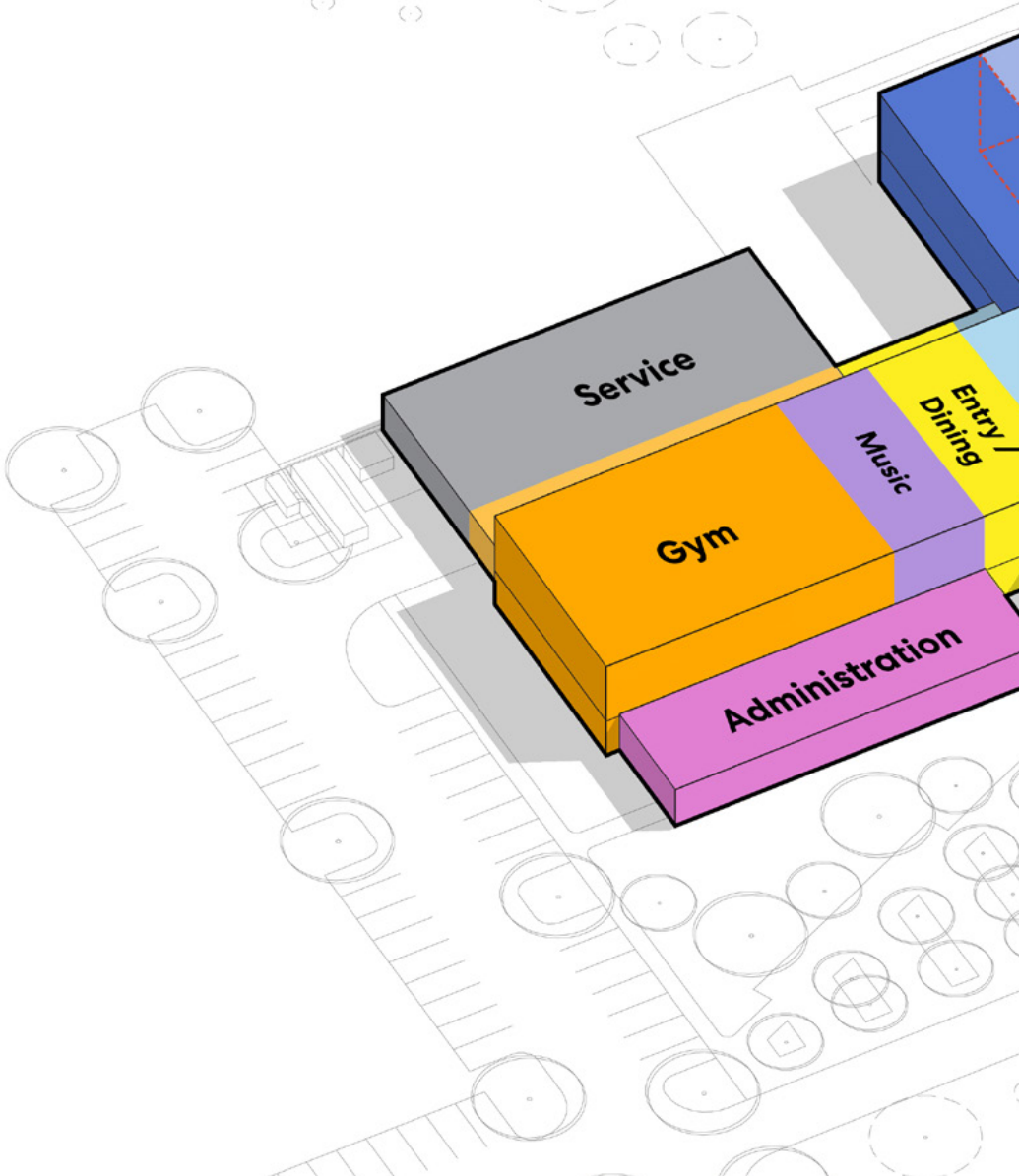


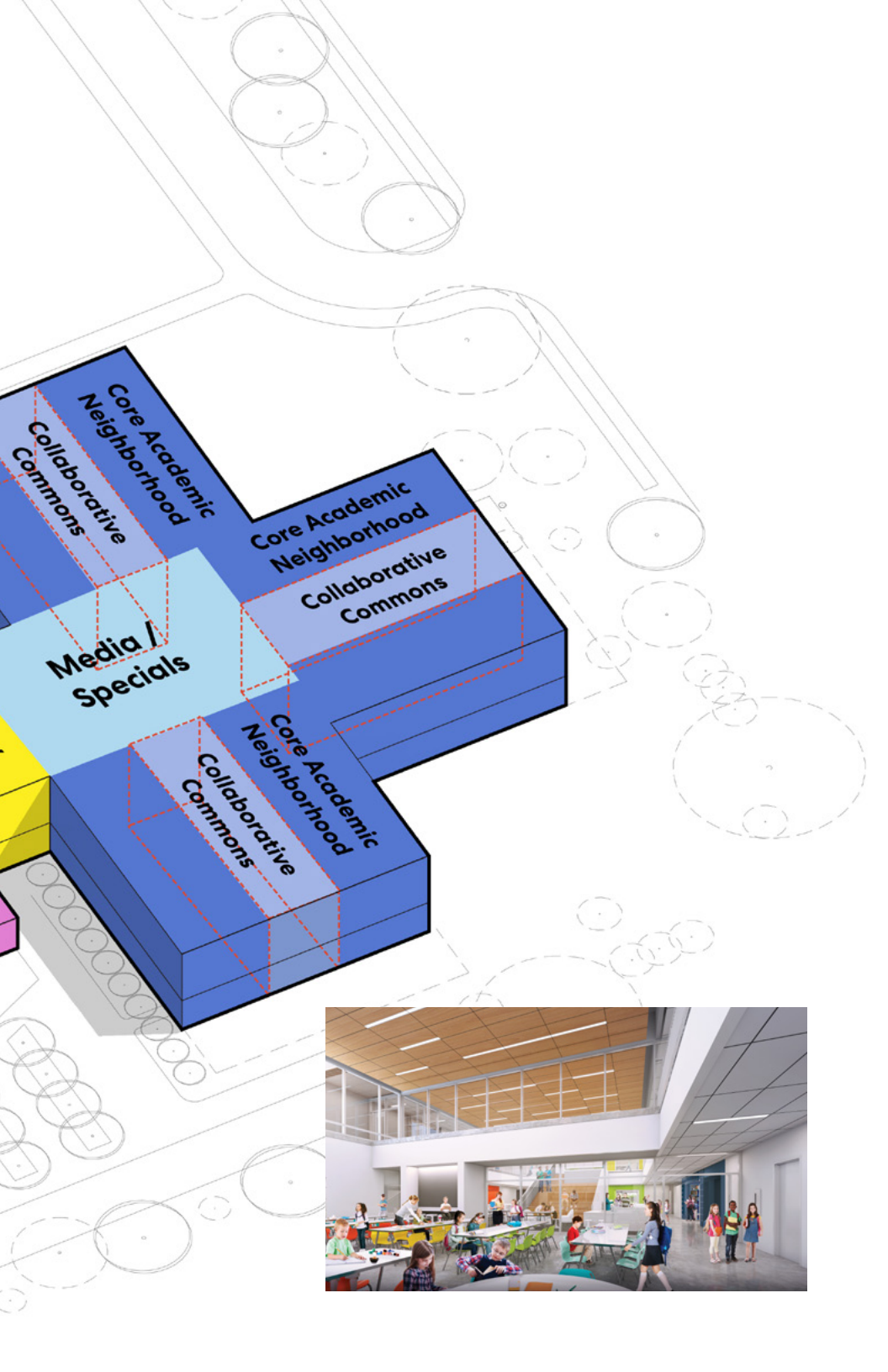
Public and Private Areas



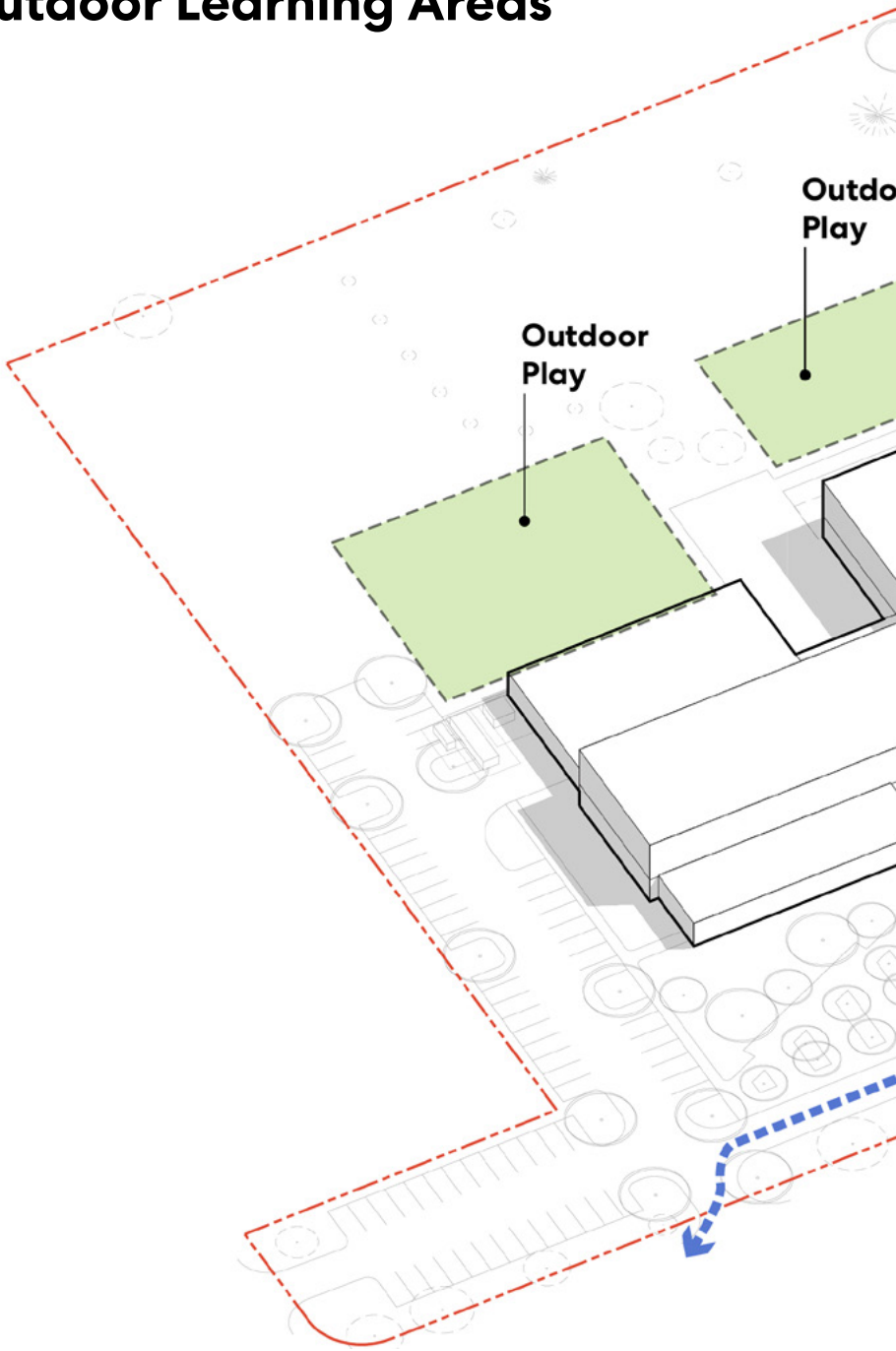


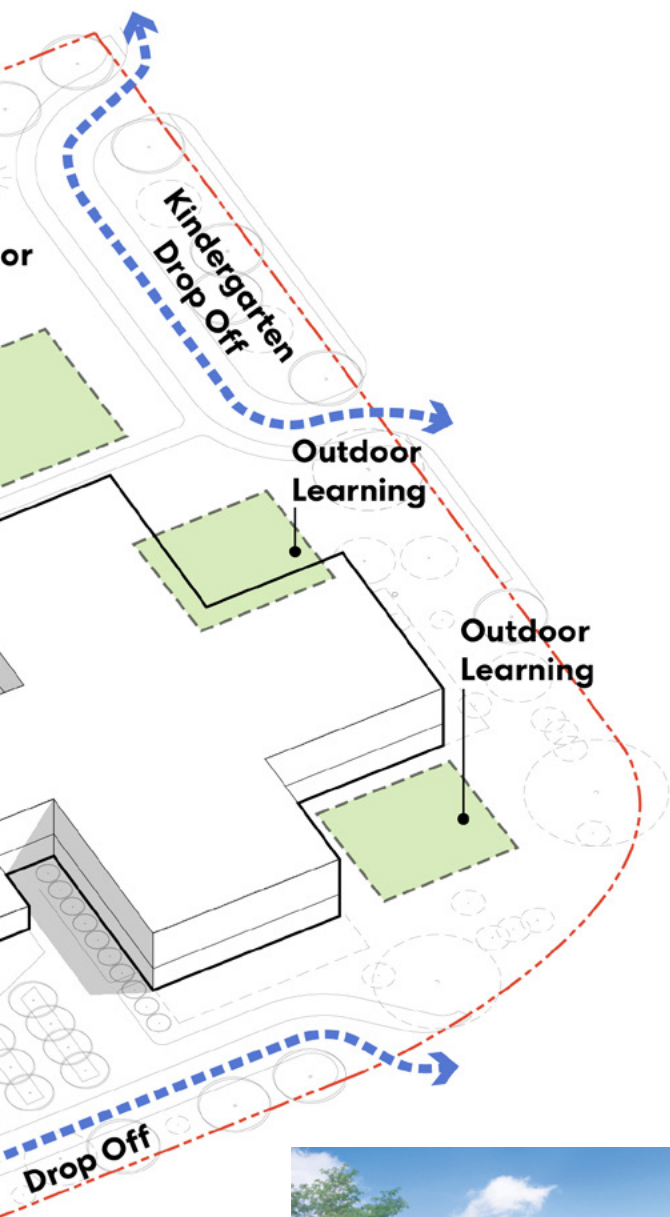
All Program Areas
