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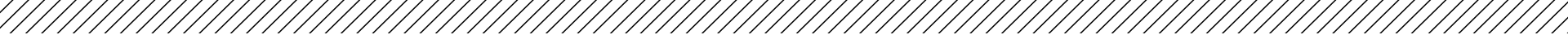

Learning Objectives

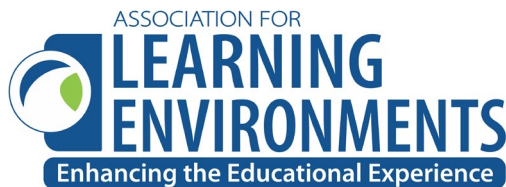
At the end of this course, participants will be able to:
