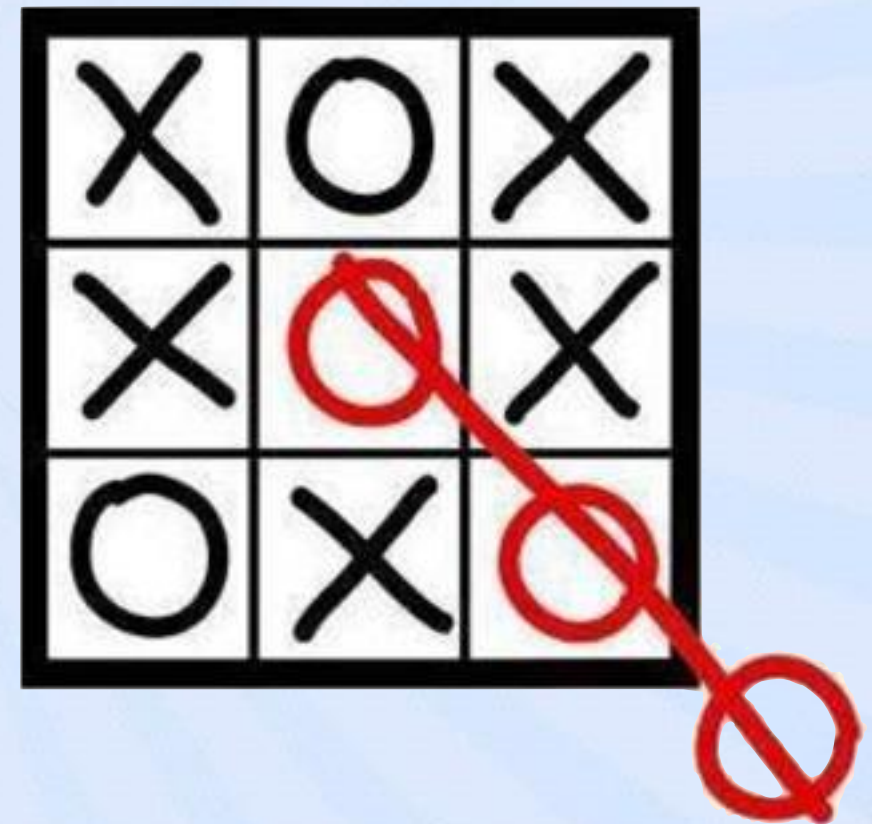

Key industries: forestry, mining, and wood products manufacturing.

Northeast

Key industries: forestry, mining, fishing; transportation and warehousing services are growing through expanding cargo shipments, a new cruise ship terminal, and pending liquefied natural gas facilities.

Key industries: lumber, pulp, and wood products manufacturing, mining, and transportation is a growing industry with intermodal facilities and an improved airport.

Key industries: manufacturing, the Gateway hub for transportation and warehousing, agriculture in the eastern on, and a strong service sector presence throughout.

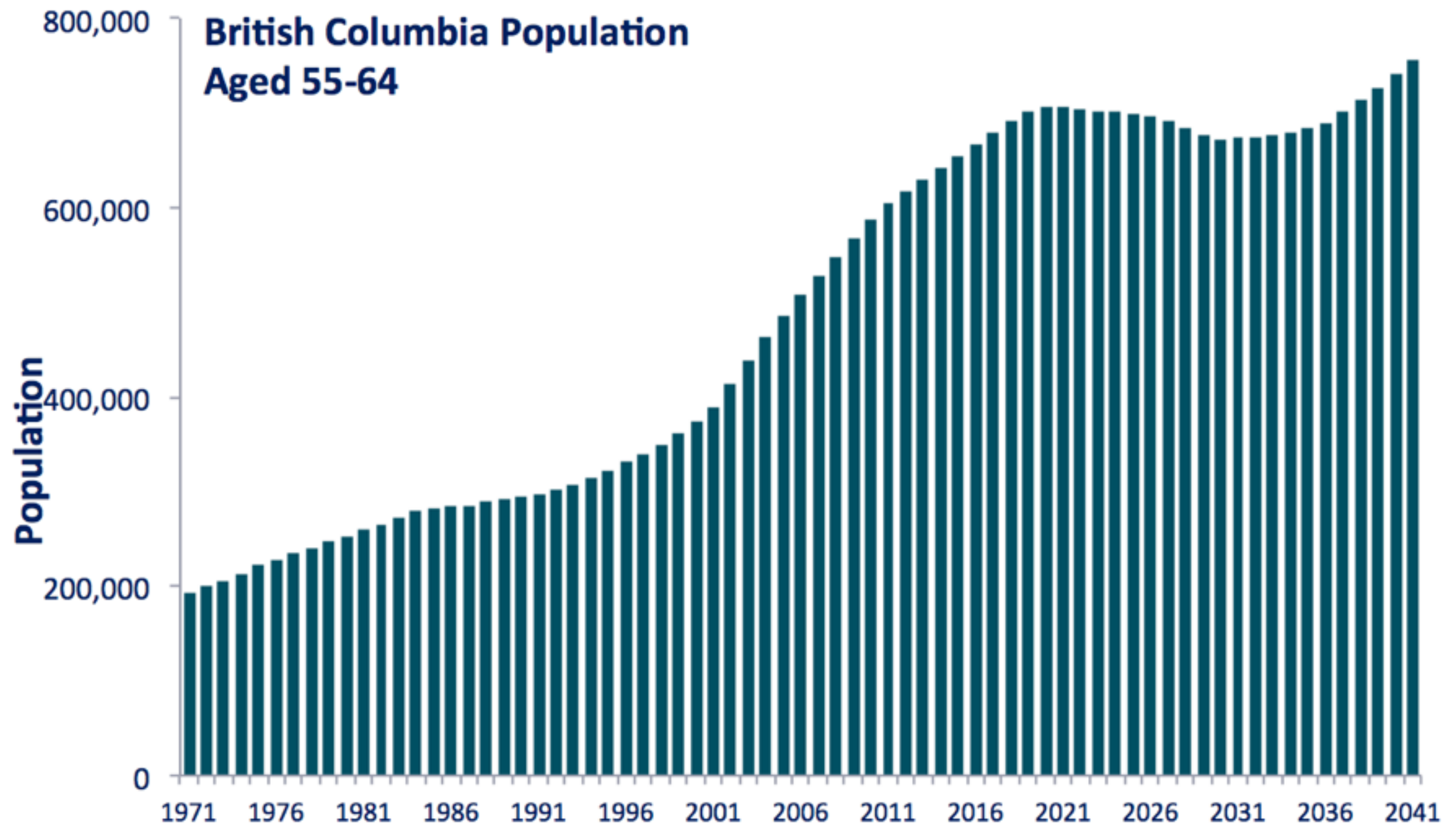

Kootenay

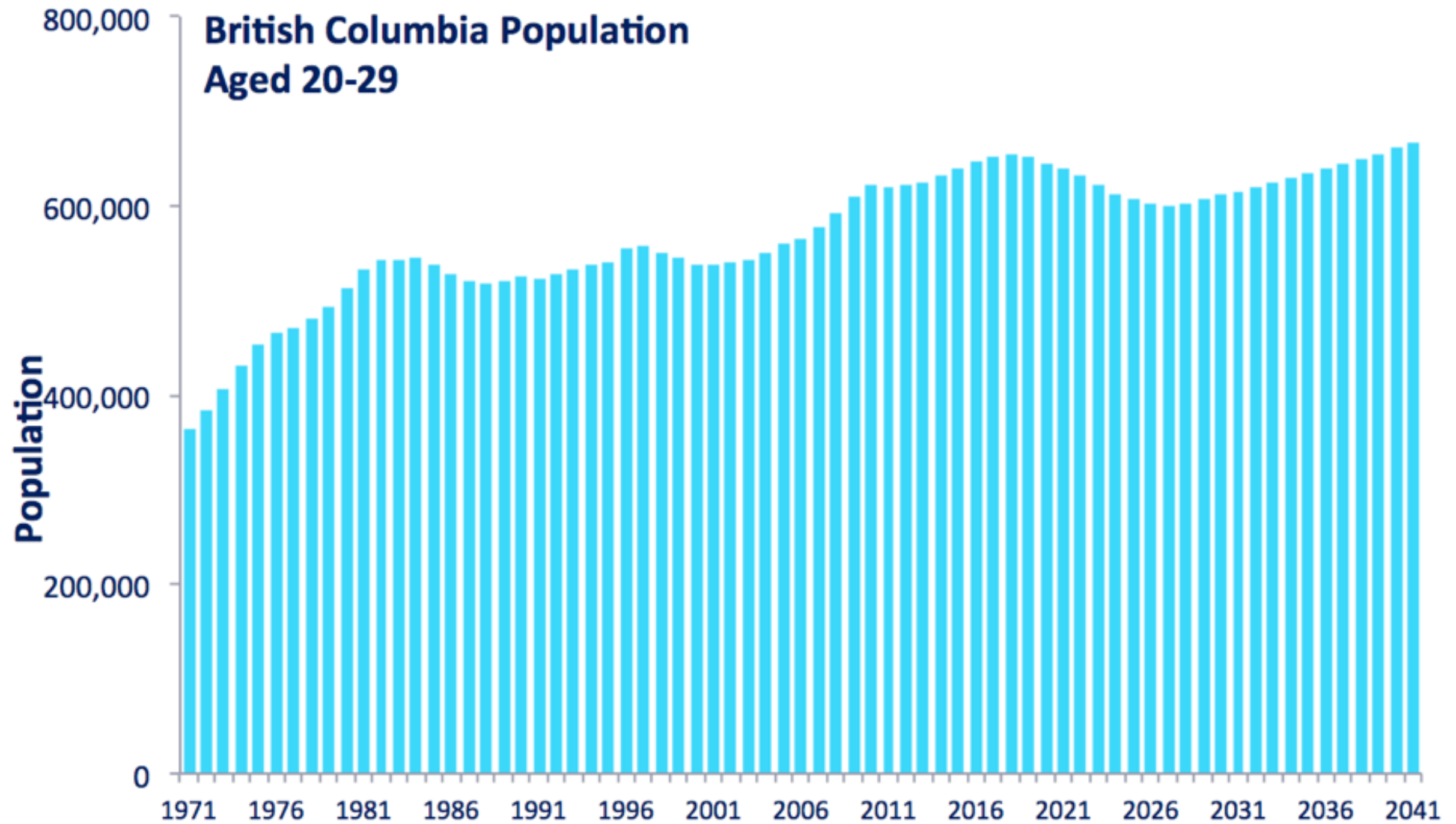

29 projects worth \$7.5B

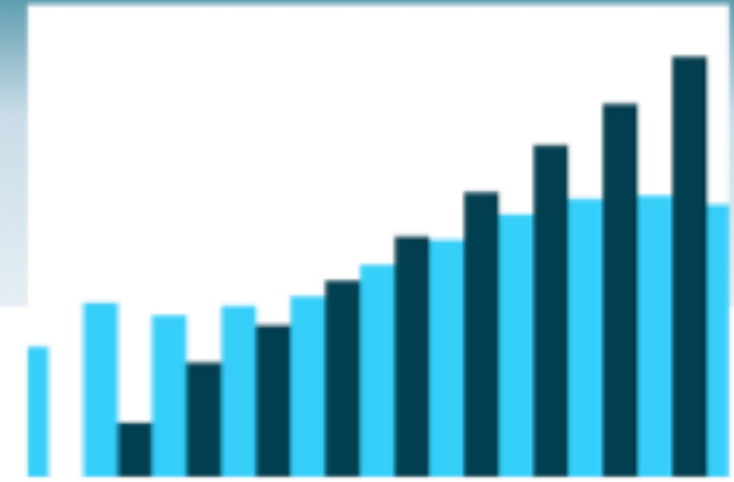
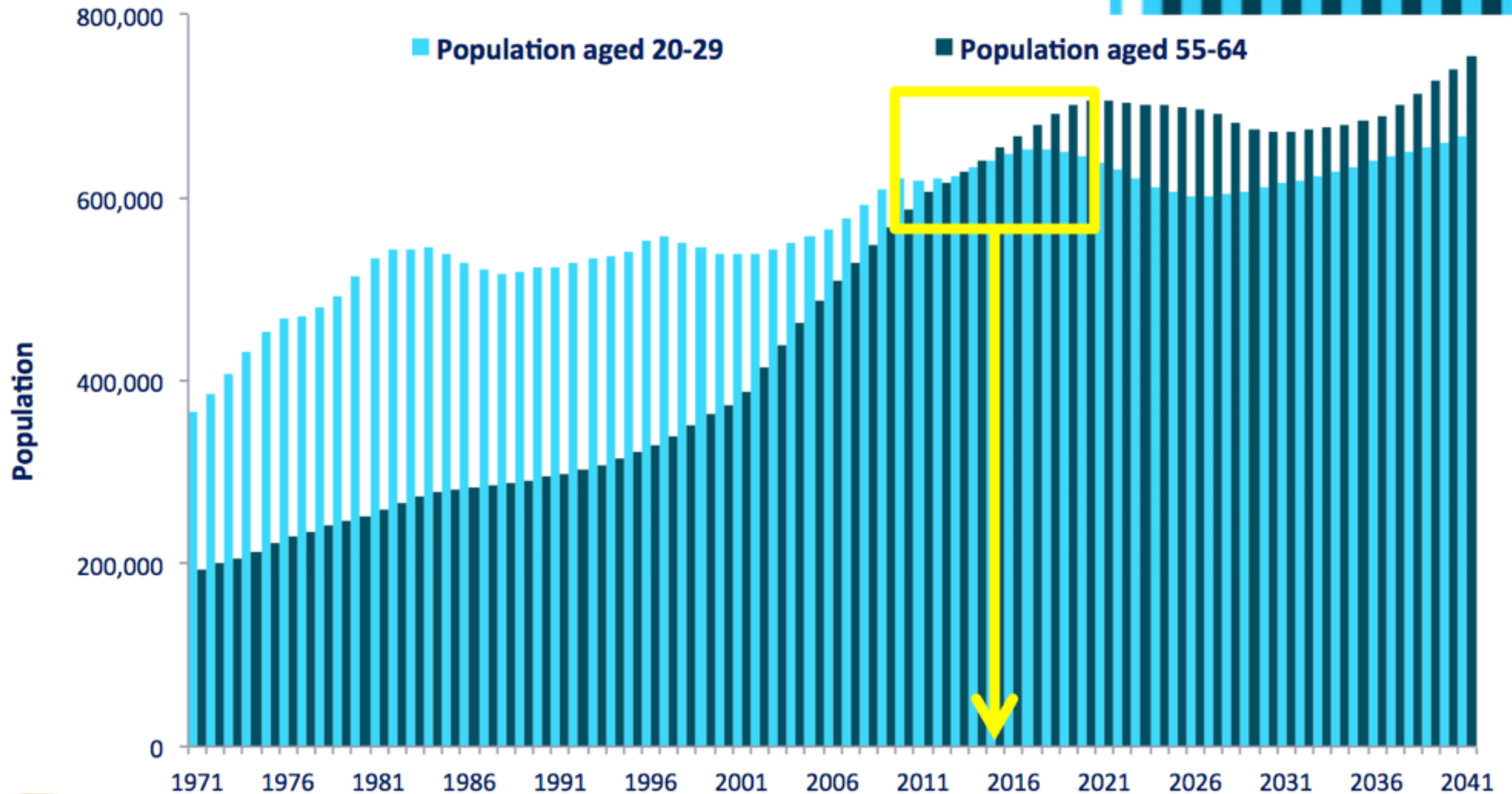




Figure 1: Loss of enthusiasm by grade level



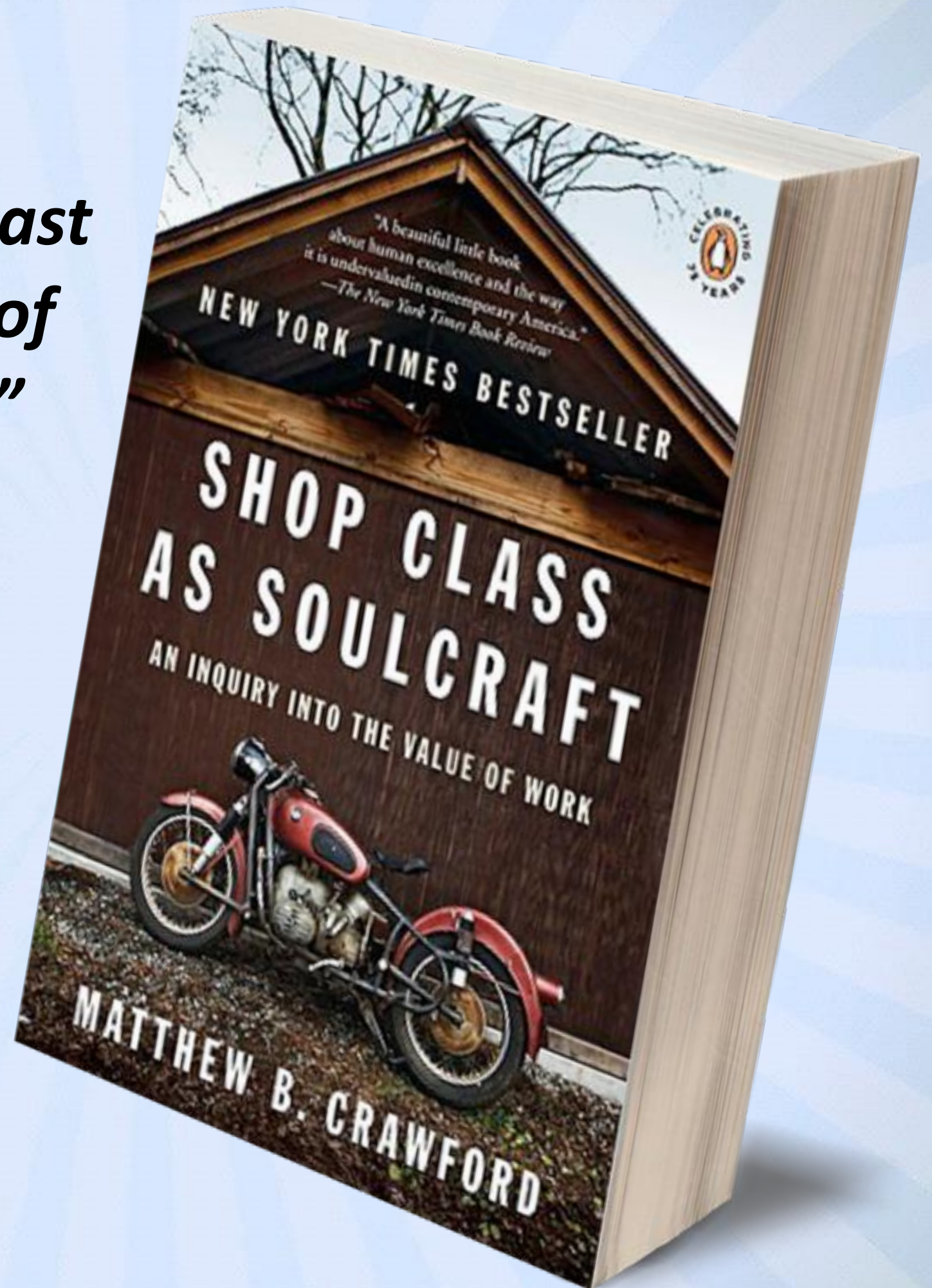
