Share information learned, and ideas gathered at the conference (along with their potential application to projects in the district or agency) by disseminating through school board presentations, staff presentations, newsletter or website distribution, or other good faith efforts to share the conference benefits with other decision-makers in their district or agency, and to others in A4LE at the local level.
