She is a consultant and designer in system change, participatory research, virtual learning, and innovation. Her research explores the thoughtful design and development of learning environments to enable quality learning, especially those in challenging contexts. She has worked to develop an immersive approach for professional learning, introducing maker education to educators locally and globally. Previously, she was a professor at the University of Calgary.

She has been a visiting professor in Bhutan, Chile, China, Papua New Guinea, Ghana, Tanzania, South Africa, and Uganda, principally in the areas design thinking, curriculum, change and innovation, appropriate technologies, and making.
