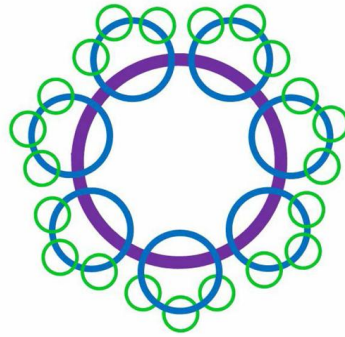
The ultimate goal is to create better learning experiences, better learning environments, and a better world.
