- III. Howard moved and Maureen seconded a motion, and the minutes of the December meeting were approved.

#### IV. **Committee Reports:**

1. Membership and Chapter Development Committee: Howard reported that there were 493 current members, down from the 520. (6) new members joined and (10) dropped; there are potentially (8) more drops-6 from Georgia, 1 each from NC and WVA. Mike Satterfield will be contacted to reach out to the Georgia members.

Barbara said that the new membership brochure that will be ready by March 3<sup>rd</sup> could be used to attract new members. Howard said that the previously scheduled CEFPI membership webinar has been postponed; Keith Webb and Howard had attended the plant mangers conference and set up a table to promote CEFPI.

Glenn said that the new fee structure that will be finalized at the next CEFPI board meeting would help recruit more public sector members.

- V. Treasurer's report (John Hill): John is working with Michelle to review and set up a tracking system to monitor expenses. There have not been major changes to the financial situation from last month and he will provide an update report next month.

- 5. Virginia (Maureen): The annual conference will be in Williamsburg on March 3-4, 2014. The feedback from the Virginia Board on Glenn's request is not very positive. The Virginia Board will meet with Glenn and other SE Board members in Williamsburg to further discuss this issue.
