








Purpose of the Competition

Competition Overview


- Students at Virginia Tech and Hampton University competed independently with the same building program, but different sites
- 2 classes total 1 class at Virginia Tech and 1 class at Hampton University \bullet

Awards per Each Class

- First Place \$500 award + conference expenses (present design)
- Second Place \$250 award + conference expenses (present design)
- Two Honorable Mentions certificate

- **Hampton University** Newport News Public Schools, Moseley Architects, RRMM Architects








Competition Overview

- Design a "Smart School" for 650 elementary students Grades K-5th
- Sites selected by Universities
- 3rd or 4th year architecture students, 6 weeks to complete
- Program was organized around energy efficient design and collaborative learning spaces that promote ${\color{black}\bullet}$ cross-curriculum integration through formal and informal learning spaces

The main courtyard is in between two shed roofs. The runoff from these roofs travels into a greywater system located beneath the main courtyard. The greywater is then used throughout the building.

The roof above the main hallway also serves as a fully accessible green roof. This area connects directly the the collaboration spaces and offers another link between the outdoors and the students of the school








"THE CORE"

Much like the human spine, A.D. Ross Elementary uses its "core" hallway to connect the academic spaces as well as the recreational spaces. This main spine creates a strong core of fun interactive learning for students outside the classroom.


The building's orientation capitalizes on natural daylighting with the many clerestorey roofs, which face south. The many roofs provide ample opportunity for the use of solar panels as well as roof gardens to help catch and retain rainwater runoff into underground water cisterns.

Strong, well-organized plan Attractive elevations Expansive use of clerestories and balconies gives design airy feel




Final Jury Comments
