**Pueblo Elementary School is a 65,000-square-foot PreK-5 campus serving 600 students in a dual-language (Spanish) immersion program. Designed to support bilingual learning, the school is organized around a central courtyard inspired by traditional plazas, fostering interaction, identity, and community.** Classrooms connect to collaborative corridors that extend learning beyond the classroom and encourage fluid movement between languages. The design integrates arts, music, and performance spaces, strengthening cultural expression. Developed through extensive community engagement, the project reflects local identity while addressing priorities such as safety, natural light, and inclusiveness. Despite budget and site constraints, the school was completed on time using efficient systems and thoughtful planning. The result is a flexible, community-centered campus that enhances learning, collaboration, and cultural belonging.
