East Ridge Elementary School is a 95,551 sq ft, two-level school with vibrant grade-level communities and strong arts support. Built on the former Horace Mann Elementary site, the school helped to ease boundary challenges for the District. Inspired by community, nature, and local identity, its CMU exterior reflects nearby Lewis Peak cliffs. Native plants and animals serve as grade-level themes with custom wall graphics. Each learning community includes four classrooms, a breakout room, and flexible collaboration space. The Learning Stair can host large gatherings and the school's music programs. East Ridge has become home to the District's Spanish immersion program, adding a meaningful layer of culture and tradition. Designed with extensive community input, the building features highly-efficient systems, insulation, and daylighting to reduce the building's energy use. Nearly every space has natural light, creating a sustainable, engaging place to learn and grow.
