Replacing a 50+ year old campus, The New Dillard Elementary School embodies the latest thoughts in school planning and sustainable design. Constructed over two increments so that the original school could remain occupied, the new school is designed to provide the students of Wilton a learning environment that transcends the classroom and begins to educate them about the importance of the built environment around them and its effect on their lives. Meanwhile the exterior architecture harkens back to the original single room Dillard schoolhouse that provides a historical tie to the community, blending the past with the future. Planned as a CHPS verified campus the school employs a single building concept with centralized facilities and single loaded, two story classroom wings to accomplish its goals.
