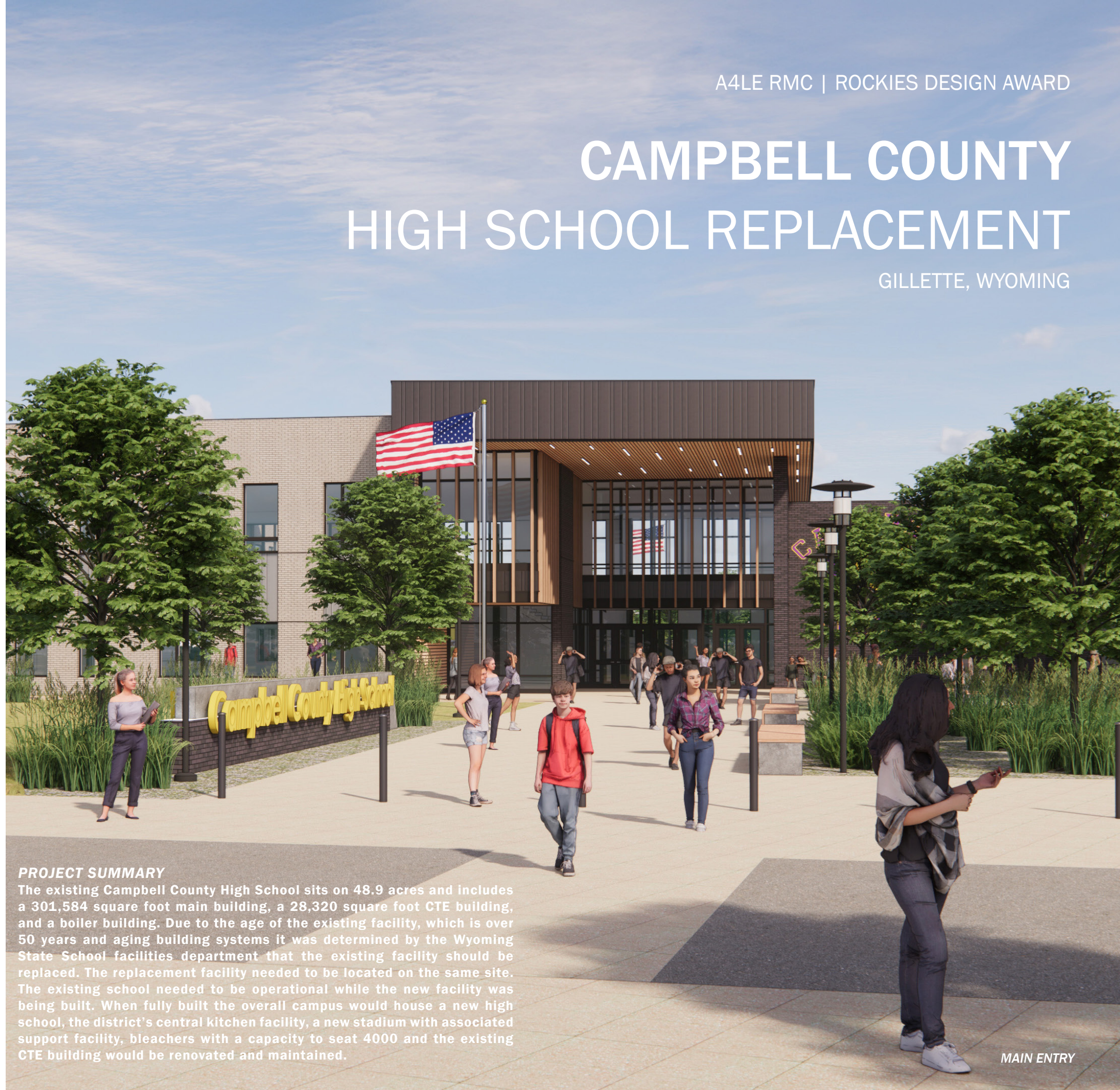

PROJECT SUMMARY

The existing Campbell County High School sits on 48.9 acres and includes a 301,584 square foot main building, a 28,320 square foot CTE building, and a boiler building. Due to the age of the existing facility, which is over 50 years and aging building systems it was determined by the Wyoming State School facilities department that the existing facility should be replaced. The replacement facility needed to be located on the same site. The existing school needed to be operational while the new facility was being built. When fully built the overall campus would house a new high school, the district's central kitchen facility, a new stadium with associated support facility, bleachers with a capacity to seat 4000 and the existing CTE building would be renovated and maintained.
