

COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

Joining a chapter committee is a great way to get acquainted with the organization and interact with the chapter board, members, and prospective members. There are a variety of opportunities outlined below. The time commitment is flexible. We desire engaged volunteers, and we understand that we all have full-time jobs. Our chapter committees meet once a month virtually. Beyond the committee meetings, you can spend as much time as you like on special committee activities/projects, whether it is volunteering to lead an initiative (greater time commitments), or supporting committee initiatives. It's up to you. All that we ask is that if you volunteer, you follow through on committee assignment commitments that you make. Today's committee members are tomorrow's board members.

Membership Committee. The Membership Committee is responsible for engaging the chapter's active members and potential members. This includes communicating important information about membership status, upcoming chapter events, and ways that members can be involved in the chapter.

Events Committee. The Events Committee is responsible for planning and executing the chapter's social events and mixers. These include the Chapter's annual design awards party, golf tournament, and other social events throughout the year.

Programs Committee. The Programs Committee is responsible for planning and executing site tours and professional development opportunities for our chapter. Site tours are planned for facilities that meet A4LE's core purpose: to strengthen learning for all through better environments. Professional development opportunities are informative, topical programs that are executed as webinars or in-person events.

Sponsorship Committee. The Sponsorship Committee is responsible for ensuring event sponsors are secured to offset the cost of executing chapter events, and help our sponsors gain visibility among our audience.
