- In general, aging infrastructure/buildings
- MD – BluePrint initiative, 10-yr/Exp 2013
 - After Covid, harder to get instructors for twilight (evenings) classes
 - Rigid framework of requirements
- Difficulty getting qualified teachers
- VA - Old buildings in flood plain
- Inappropriate space availability
- SC - Lack of industries in tourist area to draw upon
- New Centers – unsure what CTE programs will/should be offered
- Unsure of design requirements for CTE programs
- Equipment – decisions & specificity of programs + staffing
